Nobles and Ladies,

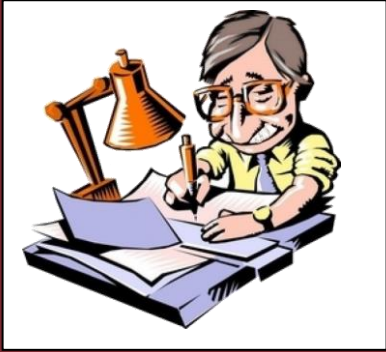
Lady Ginger and I want to thank everyone who helped, participated, and attended the 2019 Rizpah ball. You all made it a huge success.

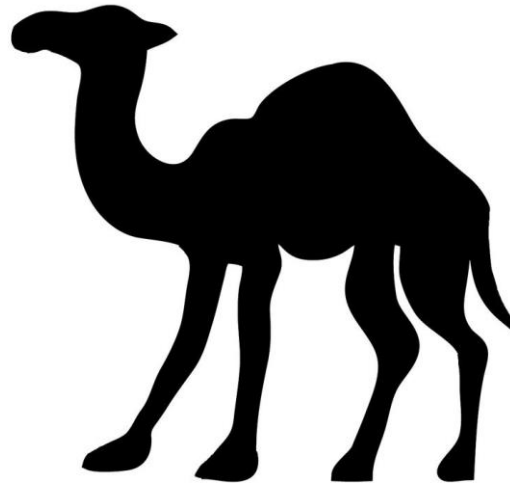
